Drive logs must:

- Include driving time total and night driving time total
- Include a signature from a parent, guardian, or other responsible adult verifying the driving time totals
- Be on an approved form:
 - DR2324 Drive Time Log Sheet
 - Parent's Supervised Driving Log from the Road Ready app
 - Supervised Driving Log from the Parent's Supervised Driving Program Handbook

CO-RCSA (SB251):
